#### Jason Brady, DMD

Jason Brady, DMD (Dentist Anesthesiologist), completed his undergraduate dental degree at the University of Nevada Las Vegas. Dr. Brady completed a hospital and private practice-based residency in Anesthesia at the University of California Los Angeles in 2012.

Dr. Brady is Past President and Diplomate of the American Dental Board of Anesthesiology. He is a past Director and Vice President of the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology. He is currently

the President of the International Federation of Dental Anesthesiology Societies and a Director of the American Society of Dentist Anesthesiologists. He is the co-developer of the Anesthesia Research Foundation's "Ten Minutes Saves a Life" emergency manual mobile application.

Dr. Brady is involved with education and serves as Co-Assistant Director for the New York University Langone Health Dental Anesthesiology program. He teaches IV sedation at the Oregon Academy of General Dentistry. He is a former faculty member of the Department of Endodontics, Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, and Orthodontics at the Ostrow School of Dentistry at the University of Southern California. He has given lectures at various organizations throughout North America, South America, Europe, and Asia. Dr. Brady practices in-office mobile anesthesia for dentistry and lives in Gilbert, AZ, with his wife and their six children.

#### Dr. Jeske is Professor, Department of General Practice and Dental Public Health and Associate Dean for Strategic Planning & Continuing Dental Education, University of Texas School of Dentistry at Houston. He earned his Ph.D. degree (pharmacology) and his DMD degree at the Medical College of Georgia. Dr. Jeske is Editor of Contemporary Dental Pharmacology: Evidence-Based

Mosby's Dental Drug Reference and Section Editor (Pharmacology) of the Journal of Craniomandibular and Sleep Practice. Her research focuses on perioperative organ injury and translational/clinical trials on perioperative acute kidney injury prevention.




# Bio Science Research Collaborative (BRC) Map and BRC Parking Information
